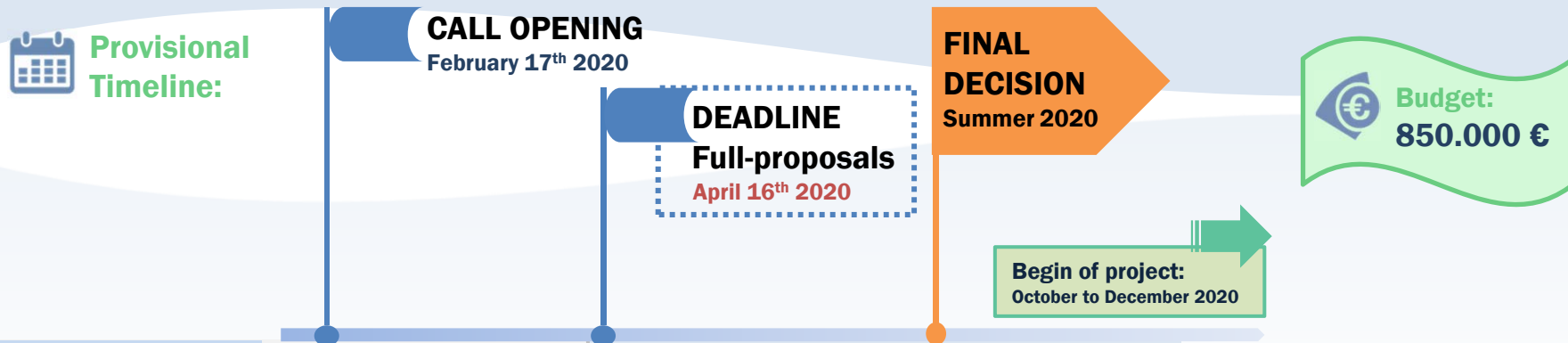


Call Pre-Announcement – 2020 Transfer Project Call

> Research and development for supporting knowledge transfer, scientific networking, and public engagement based on AquaticPollutants joint transnational projects<



The Transfer Project will be part of the AquaticPollutants ERA-Net Cofund action and support the AquaticPollutants cofunded call projects. The objective is to realize a better and wider dissemination, develop new innovative methods to support the transfer of research and the uptake of results into the public and administrative sector, policy, industry or economy. This will lead to a greater and focused impact and increase the awareness of projects' outcomes. Moreover, cross-cutting issues, that address all transnational projects alike, can better be dealt with. The implementation of a Transfer Project will in addition lead to a better alignment of the three participating JPIs and improve their collaboration possibilities.

2 Implementation and valorisation of new methods for transfer, communication, and dissemination

- > Strategic support in the transfer of research results of AquaticPollutants projects
- > Scientific networking with other thematically relevant national, European and possibly international research actors
- > Increased involvement of and communication with stakeholders and citizens
- > Knowledge Transfer
- > Coordination and networking within the funded projects
- > Publication and Public Relations
